Undergraduate Aid for College Tuition for children of clergy - Once a year the fund will divide a lump sum for the purpose of assisting children of clergy who are in college. Requests will be received from January until June 1st for the succeeding academic year. Maximum amount of a tuition grant will be \$2,000 per student per academic school year. Applications received after the due date of June 1, if awarded, may be subject to a 10% penalty reduction. Grant requests must be supported with the necessary backup documentation. The committee does not generally award grants for post-graduate tuition. The committee will consider all requests for college tuition grants at one meeting during the year. The June meeting is preferable.

Aid for Primary or Secondary School - Requests are accepted for children who have special needs and for children of canonically resident priests in critical mission areas where public schooling is clearly inadequate. The priests may apply at any time during the year, but only one grant per child, per academic year, will be awarded.
