Undergraduate Aid for College Tuition for children of clergy - Once a year the fund will divide a lump sum for the purpose of assisting children of clergy who are in college. Grant requests must be supported with the necessary backup documentation. The committee does not generally award grants for post-graduate tuition.

Aid for Primary or Secondary School - Requests are accepted for children who have special needs and for children of canonically resident priests in critical mission areas where public schooling is clearly inadequate. The priests may apply at any time during the year, but only one grant per child, per academic year, will be awarded.
