1. Cleric lives in his own house

Resolution of the vestry 12/31/2005

Whereas the Rev. Mary J. Platt is employed as a minister of the Gospel by the St. Swithin's Church, Staten Island, New York, which does not provide a residence for hER, the vestry resolves that of the total compensation of \$42,300 to be paid to The Rev. Mary J. Platt during 2006, that \$24,000 be designated a parsonage allowance within the meaning of that term as used in Section 107 of the IRS Code of 1986, but in any event until further notice the parsonage allowance shall be \$2,000 per month.

2. Cleric lives in rectory provided by the church Resolution of the vestry 12/31/2005

Whereas the Rev. Mary J. Platt is employed as a minister of the Gospel by the St. Swithin's Church, Staten Island, New York, which although providing a residence for her does not provide full cost of maintaining and furnishing such a residence; the vestry resolves that of the total compensation of \$42,300 to be paid to The Rev. Mary J. Platt during 2006, that \$2,400 be designated a parsonage allowance within the meaning of that term as used in Section 107 of the IRS Code of 1986, but in any event until further notice the parsonage allowance shall be \$200 per month.
