This clergyperson will work under the supervision and mentorship of the Rector, who has more than 20 years of ordained experience, and the wardens and vestry of SMST.

The job description is adaptable to the right candidate for SMST and their gifts in ministry. Ideal qualifications include fluency in Spanish and English, ability to work with different constituencies (breadth of economic backgrounds, language, sexuality, ages, gender expression, race, ethnicity, etc.), knowledge of social media platforms as well as comfort in learning new technology, creative, has initiative and can work independently.
