### INTRODUCTION

#OneSingleAct is a call to action for individuals and communities to spark change through one simple, meaningful act and to invite others to do the same. It's a movement rooted in the belief that every act of care, courage, or connection has the power to ripple outward, transforming our culture from one of division into one of compassion and shared purpose.

People of all faiths, backgrounds, and communities are invited to show up with intention. Whether it's checking in on a neighbor, volunteering, donating to a food pantry, speaking out for justice, offering your time or talent to create art, building moments of connection, or simply extending everyday kindness to people - each act, no matter how big or small - counts.

This campaign is co-presented by the Episcopal Diocese of New York, The Cathedral Church of St. John the Divine, Episcopal Charities, Episcopal Divinity School, and the Interfaith Center of New York. It's built on a simple, powerful framework:

- Post one act of care, courage, or connection using the hashtag #OneSingleAct
- Share one act by someone else on the #OneSingleAct hashtag to amplify their impact
- Tag one other person/ organization to keep the chain going

For 100 days, the Episcopal Diocese of New York will post and highlight these stories, and we invite you to participate. This guide offers ideas and tools to help you take part in #OneSingleAct, and to inspire others to join.

### **BEST PRACTICES/ GUIDELINES FOR POSTING**

- Always use **#OneSingleAct** in your caption when posting. This makes it easier to find each others' stories and cross-highlight them, in what is a community-based campaign
- Try to use the <u>Banner Logo</u>, <u>Stacked Logo</u>, or <u>Icon</u> on your images, or as a part of your post, to easily visually communicate that your post is part of the #OneSingleAct campaign. (see below for sample posts)
- If you are overlaying the logo on an image, place it on the top or bottom corners of the image to not obscure it. Place it on lighter/ darker backgrounds to ensure visibility.
- This campaign is designed primarily for Facebook and Instagram. However we encourage you to expand to other social networks like X, LinkedIn, and TikTok, as per your audiences. ### THE FRAMEWORK

The framework for participating in the campaign is simple:

- Post 1 Post about an act of care, courage, or connection that has impacted you, with
  the hashtag #OneSingleAct in your caption. This can be something you did, or what
  someone did for you or a community. If you're posting on behalf of an organization, you
  can post about the impact of your programs, or the work of your community members.
  You can post images, video, or text-based messages whatever you think best captures
  the impact of this act.
- Share 1 Click on the #OneSingleAct hashtag or search for #OneSingleAct, and it will take you to all the other posts, from all corners of the internet, that have been shared as a part of this campaign. Choose one that resonates with you this could be from a stranger, your friend, a community member, or partner organization. Share this post on to your Facebook or Instagram stories with the #OneSingleAct hashtag. Others participating in the campaign may choose to boost your post as well. This helps maximize the impact of all these stories, and brings them to all-new audiences, breaking through the silos that exist within social media.
- Tag 1 At the end of your caption, tag the account of someone you'd like to nominate to
  participate in this campaign, to keep the chain going. We see this as a way to keep these
  stories and acts of care, courage, and connection growing, and inspire people from all
  walks of life to participate.




### SAMPLE POSTS AND SAMPLE CAPTIONS

**Sample caption:** Today, I volunteered with (organization) to tutor high-school students in my city.
