Amu Mudenda is a public health practitioner with experience in malaria elimination, advocacy, and strategic coordination. He works in the Diocese of Lusaka and plays a pivotal role in Zambia's National Malaria Elimination Program. As the Regional Coordinator for Faith Leader Advocacy for Malaria Elimination (FLAME) - Secretariat, Amu has guided a strong coalition of faith leaders spanning Christian, Islamic, Hindu and Bahai communities, supporting the existing FLAME secretariats in Angola, Namibia, and Zambia, and currently supporting the establishment of new FLAME secretariats in Mozambique, Zimbabwe, Malawi, and parts of the Democratic Republic of Congo. He is passionate that malaria interventions be equitable and has supported Zambia's End Malaria Council's Launch in resource mobilization and strategic engagement.
